

We are making improvements to our West Entrance, main level bathrooms, creating 5 private study rooms, a multi-purpose collaboration space on the main level, a new public access meeting space, an updated youth services and teen area and a family restroom on the lower level.

Please be patient with us as we transition this Fall. We will remain open and accessible to the public during renovation and construction. Collections may be limited. But you can still place holds, get new library cards and have access to all our other wonderful services. Although we can't accommodate in-building programing during this time, be on the lookout for us throughout the South Holland Community. Please pardon the mess. We look forward to sharing our many updates with you soon.
