

- 2. Update Emergency ResponseProcedures and Policies post building renovation.
- 3.Install new fire system updates by FY2024-2025.
- 4. Sustain Funding for upcoming Roofing and other capital improvement projects by FY2025 or later.
- 1. Establish a Library of Things collection based on community survey and analysis.
- 2.Create an informed, sustainable collection development plan and policy.
